FYI – in accordance with our liability insurance, all campers and storage items (i.e. boats and trailers, ect.) must have current license plates, proof of insurance, and a current land use form on file as soon as possible. At the very latest, this should be turned in with your annual fee.

Annual camper/storage fees will be due May 1st and will be as follows:

Small(under 14ft.)/Soft Sided Campers.....	\$220.00
Large(14ft.+)/Hard Sided Campers.....	\$270.00
All Other Storage.....	\$200.00 each piece

Camping: A letter to the Board is required before any camper is brought to the club. If you have a camper on the grounds or are thinking of having one, please read over the new rules. If you just camp for a night there is a small nightly fee. Check the rules. Copies of the rules can be found in the clubhouse on the bulletin board.
