**Annual camper/storage fees will be due May 1<sup>st</sup> and will be as follows:**

Small (under 14ft.)/Soft Sided Campers.....	\$220.00
Large (14ft. +)/Hard Sided Campers.....	\$270.00
All Other Storage.....	\$200.00 each piece

Camping: A letter to the Board is required before any camper is brought to the club. If you have a camper on the grounds or are thinking of having one, please read over the new rules. If you just camp for a night there is a small nightly fee. Check the rules. Copies of the rules can be found in the clubhouse on the bulletin board.
