It's that time of year....camper and storage fees come due May 1st. Sorry to say, all fees are going up. Hard shell campers and trailers - 20ft. and over, will be \$200.00 per year. Pop-up campers and trailers under 20ft. will be \$150.00 per year. ALL campers need to be marked on the tongue with the responsible party's name. Also, check the rules, you must keep the grass cut around your camper or trailer or you will be charged for it. Just a reminder.....you MUST HAVE BOARD APPROVAL BEFORE BRINGING ANY NEW CAMPER ON THE GROUNDS!!
